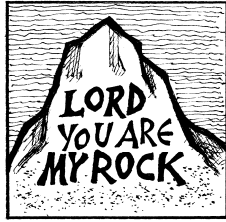

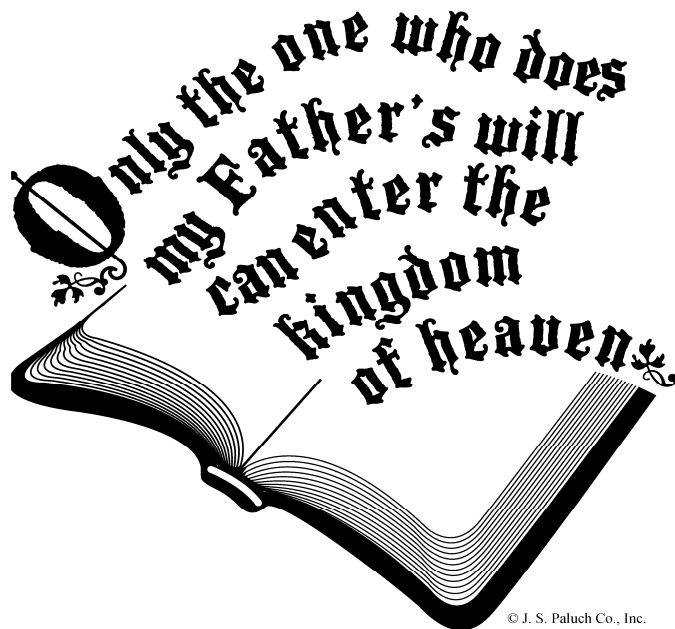
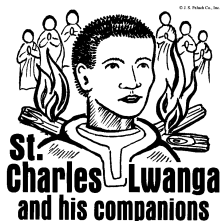
Booth Sponsors & Volunteers
