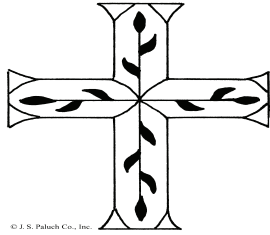

Docent Program Looking for Bearers of Light

In anticipation of over 200,000 visitors in the first year, the **Cathedral of Christ the Light** is seeking enthusiastic, people-oriented individuals to be a part of the first group of docents. A docent, from the Latin, (*to teach*) is a person of faith who volunteers to lead tours of the new Cathedral.

The qualifications for docent candidates are that they are outgoing, enthusiastic communicators who will lead tours from 1-2 hours; willing to learn detailed information about the Cathedral and its history that will enable them to tell stories; able to work with the Cathedral's diverse population encompassing children and adults of all nationalities and educational backgrounds; comfortable in speaking to groups of up to twenty visitors; organized, flexible problem-solvers; and lifelong learners, willing to examine, assess, and adopt new information into their tours.

Requirements and training include completing the application and personal interview; attending the orientation session and completing the docent training program; giving a two-year commitment to the program and serve at least eight hours each month; maintaining a regular tour schedule; participating in the on-going enrichment opportunities for the docents.

Docent candidates with the above qualifications and who speak another language other than English such as Spanish or Vietnamese are strongly encouraged to apply.

Becoming a docent at the Cathedral of Christ the Light is a wonderful opportunity for ministry and a rewarding way to share you time and talent. It might also provide a way for you to deepen in your faith and to gain personal and professional experience working with the community.

Docents at the cathedral receive additional benefits and incentives which include professional development through on-going training and enrichment; percentage discount at Gift Shop and Café; opportunities to attend guest lectures and events; community service hours or credit; recognition events for your participation; and engagement with a community of dedicated ministers.

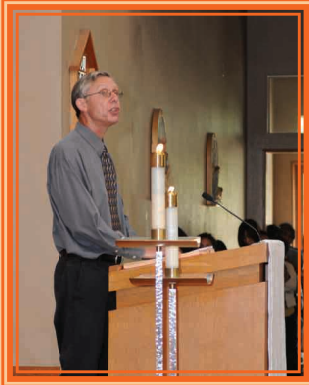
Girls Basketball and Co-ed Track and Field sign-ups will be held in November and December.
