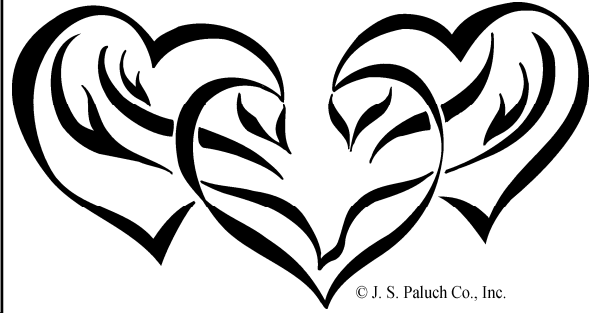

[T]he love of God has been poured out into our hearts
through the Holy Spirit.

— *Romans 5:5b*



My dear friends in Christ,

It is spring time but somehow winter has not left us. The skies continue to be dark and we continue to experience rain. Is this a blessing or a curse? Whatever it is, we are experiencing a mystery before our eyes. And this Trinity Sunday we are dealing with another mystery: ***the mystery of our faith***. Our faith tells us that there is one God but has three persons: God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Very confusing concept!

I remember when I was in grade school, I asked the nun to explain to us the Holy Trinity. She said to me that she couldn't explain it.

This is what we are celebrating today: the mystery of our faith that we cannot understand but something we live and we believe. In fact, the gospel today is not about a theological or academic discourse of the Holy Trinity. The Church holds that it is better to change our lives and to follow the gospel than to know the deep theology of this mystery of our faith.

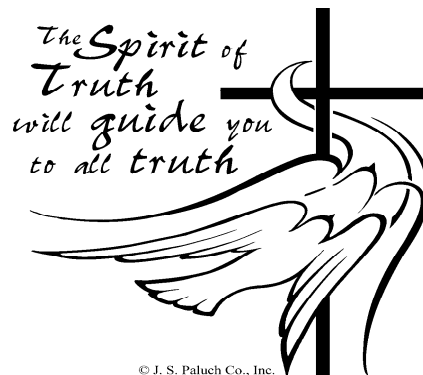
What we know is that Holy Trinity has been part in the history and salvation of humanity. Through their loving relationships, we experience the Trinity in the world we live and in our life. It is in this loving relationship that the mystery of the Holy Trinity is revealed, experienced and celebrated!

We already know the essential facts about the Trinity according to the Bible and the faith of the Church. ***God is the loving Father***, source of life and happiness. ***God is the Son***, who came to us as our brother, our savior and our example. ***God is the Spirit***, love personified, who dwells in us and fills the ends of the world to make all things anew.

So the main thing is not to be able to explain the Trinity, but the main thing is the ability of this mystery to change our hearts and increase our love.

This is the meaning of the Holy Trinity. It is the manifestation of God's love for us.

St. Peregrine, The Cancer Saint

Peregrine labored for years as a brother in the Order of the Servants of Mary (Servites). At age 60 he was diagnosed with cancer of the leg brought on by many years of disciplined prayer while standing, resulting in varicose veins that became ulcerous. On the night before the scheduled amputation of his leg, Peregrine dragged himself to the foot of the cross in the community chapter room and fell into a deep trace-like sleep. Upon waking, he discovered that his leg was completely cured.

Because of the miracle wrought by prayer, the Church canonized him in 1726. His the patron of those battling cancer and other life-threatening diseases, including **HIV-AIDS**. His Feast Day is May 4.

The lesson of Peregrine's life is not only that God worked a miracle, but that a faithful, trustful servant placed himself, unconditionally, in the hands of our Lord. Peregrine's trust in God can be a model for us in dealing with the pain, sickness and crossed of our lives.

The second St. Peregrine Healing Mass and blessing with a relic of St. Peregrine will be offered at St. Anne's on Tuesday, June 1 at 7:30 pm in the Church. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will also be available for the chronically or seriously ill. This healing mass and blessing with the holy relic of St. Peregrine will be held on the first Tuesday of each month.

Hope you can help: Small appliances, clothing (all sizes) children' toys, books, backpacks, school supplies, linens, bedspreads, sheets, towels, table clothes, napkins, blankets, small electronic items in good working condition, clocks, radios, tables, chairs, lamps, pictures, desk, living and bedroom furniture, lounge chairs, patio furniture, utensils, dishes, bowls, glasses, cups, pots and pans, baking pans, roasters, serving platters, picture frames. All furniture and E-waste materials must be delivered directly to the booth on Saturday, July 24th.
