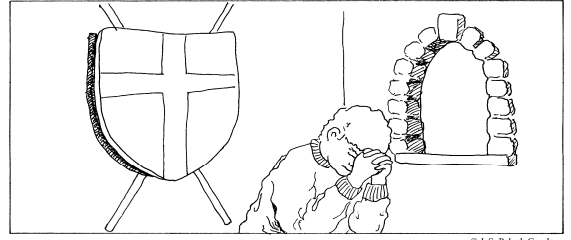

My dear friends in Christ,

It has been a very fulfilling week for our parish community. The parish festival was a great success! Many thanks again to the many people that put together an amazing weekend.

During the next three weeks different ministry groups and organization will be gathering for workshops and renewal. I asked Rico Monton, our Liturgy Coordinator, to put these things together. There is a need for renewal and engagement. We need to refocus again so that we can discover the powerful meaning of our calling.

We have a lot of work to deal with during the next few months. We are putting a master plan together so that we have a greater sense of our priorities. The carpet as you know needs to be replaced. It is a very old part of our environment that requires immediate attention. There are many spots that now have become so dangerous. In fact I almost tripped on one of them as I was processing to the altar during the mass. We are also designing a new baptismal font as part of the master plan. When the master plan is ready, I will let you know.

Last month I was informed by the Facilities Committee about the major projects involving the removal of trees that have bothered some of our neighbors. Also our parking pavement on the first section of the parking lot is very bumpy. This happened because of the trees along the Cabello Street side whose roots uprooted the pavement. These are some of the major projects that we need to deal with. These projects require funding. These are realities we cannot ignore. I ask for your cooperation and support on these ones. I know that these things will again challenge our will and our spirit. But I am very confident that you will be with me on these ones.

We have finished many projects during the last six months. I hope that we are appreciative of these things. The doors are new and of course our two memorial gardens. Your participation is of great importance.

I'm always grateful for your wonderful sense of stewardship. Our parish is slowly capturing this spirit as a way of life. I know that many of us continue to struggle with this. The concept of stewardship still is very foreign to us and it will take a while before we can fully understand its meaning. Slowly we are getting. It requires humility and great faith for this to happen. My hope is that our parish will become a stewardship parish so that our gathering in many events such as the parish festival will be a gathering to promote goodwill and friendship among us and not as a fundraising event.

STEWARDSHIP OF TIME (REDUCE WASTE AND RECYCLE)

All parishioners are invited and encouraged to participate in our parish community's effort in reducing waste and recycling when opportunities arise that your presence and/or participation is needed during parish event(s) and meeting(s) in the parish hall and/or classroom(s). Recycle bins and appropriately labeled boxes were placed in the parish hall and a small recycle bin in each classroom.

We collect and redeem recyclable items as follows:

Plastic Bottles (all sizes), Glass bottles (all colors), Aluminum cans (all sizes), (*with CRV on bottle label*)

Note: CRV means California Redemption Value

Proceeds from our recycling efforts go to the parish general fund while reducing waste expense incurred when parish events and meetings had occurred.

With due respect to God's gift of parishioners time, health and safety of facility maintenance staff and parishioner volunteers when sorting and collecting recyclables for redemption, *parishioners help and support are requested to observe and follow simple processes:* Before discarding recyclables, there must be *no residual liquid* in each container. (In compliance with State of California's health regulations, (*i.e., Anti Liquid Law*)). Place your empty container(s) in appropriately labeled recycle bin. Plastic and glass bottles can be discarded in the same recycle bin in the parish hall. Place your empty container(s), (plastic bottles, aluminum cans, glass bottles) in the blue recycle bin in the classroom.

Please *do not dump trash* in recycle bins.

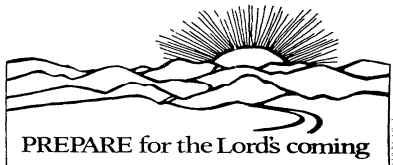
