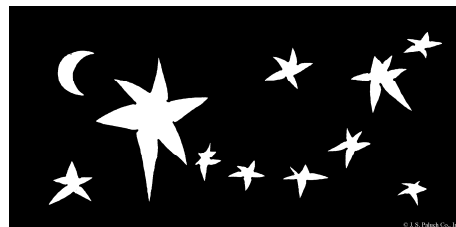
## ***PARISH MISSION...***

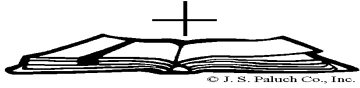
### Gather Good Together in Christ Celebrating 50 years - Diocese of Oakland

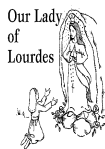
