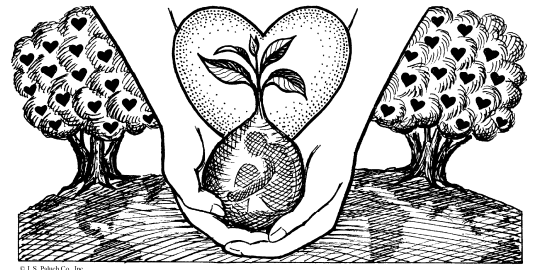

***My dear friends in Christ,***

**This weekend is a special time to honor and to give thanks to our mothers! *I would like* to share this story that was written by a certain Emma Bombeck, who reflected on being mother!**

**Every mother has a favorite child.** She is only human! I have mine---the child for whom I feel a special closeness, with whom I share a love that no one could possibly understand. ***My favorite child is the one who was too sick to eat ice cream at his birthday party...*** who had measles at Christmas...who wore leg braces to bed because he toed in....***who had a fever in the middle of the night, the asthma attack, the child in my arms at the emergency ward.***

**My favorite child spent Christmas alone away from the family,** was stranded after the game with a gas tank on E, lost the money for his class ring.

**My favorite child is** the one who messed up the piano recital, ***misspelled committee in a spelling bee,*** ran the wrong way with the football, and had his bike stolen because he was careless.

**My favorite child is the one** I punished for lying, grounded for insensitivity to other people's feelings, and informed he was a royal pain to the entire family.

**My favorite child always needed a haircut,** had a hair that wouldn't curl, had no date for Saturday night, and a car that cost \$600 to fix. My favorite child was selfish, immature, ***bad-tempered and self-centered.*** He was vulnerable, lonely, unsure of what he was doing in this world---and quite wonderful.

**All mothers have their favorite child.** It is always the same one: the one who needs you at the moment, who needs you for whatever reason---to cling to, to shout at, to hurt, to hug, to flatter, to reverse charges to, to unload on---but mostly just to be there!

***This is true! Our mothers are still the first person we think of when we fall down and when we get hurt!***

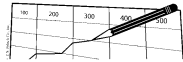
