2012 Interfaith Blood Drive

The Interfaith Blood Drive is an effort of the American Red Cross, the Catholic Church, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and numerous other faith communities in the greater Bay Area during the month of July. Last year was the first year of this drive and an impressive 1,700 units of blood were collected. This year's goal is to double that amount. Why July? It is because that generally during this the time of year blood donations decrease while the need increases. Individuals who are at least 17 years of age (16 with parental permission), meet height and weight requirements (at least 110 pounds based on height) and are in generally good physical health may be eligible to donate blood.
