UNDERSTANDING OUR FAITH: THE CHURCH as ONE

My dear friends in Christ,

In a few weeks we will celebrate Thanksgiving Day! A special day to gather with family and friends to give thanks to God for his many blessings! ***Giving thanks to God, the source of everything that we have, always has a good reward. It gives a sense of joy, meaning and fulfillment!*** Our Lord Jesus demands from us that we should be a people of gratitude! Glory to God in the highest!

Last week I wrote an article about the Church as HOLY and as UNIVERSAL! This weekend I would like to share with you the CHURCH as ONE!

“I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me. And I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me (John 17:20-23).”

This prayer of Jesus the Christ is realized today in the oneness which is present amid a remarkable diversity among the followers of Christ. The members of Christ's Body live in every country of the world and belong to every race on earth. Even though they have different cultures, different tastes, different political opinions and speak different languages, ***they are one in the great unity of the Body of Christ.***

But the reality however is that there are millions of men and women who love Christ and worship him as their Savior and their God who are separated from full unity with the Church. The prayer of Christ for the unity among his members is a prayer also for their complete reunion.

So what are the bonds of the Church's unity?

The ultimate foundation for the unity of the Church is love. Unity is also assured by the affirmation of one faith, by the common life of divine worship, and by the apostolic succession given to the Church through the sacrament of Holy Orders.

Can there be more than one true Church of Christ?

This is always a challenge for all of us especially when you meet people of different religion who would claim this distinction. I would say that there cannot be more than one true Church of Christ ***because the Church is Christ!*** Christ cannot be divided. There is but ***one body and one Spirit, as you were called to the one hope of your call; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all (Eph 4:4-6).***

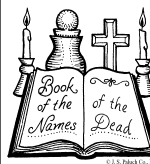
