+Sacrament of Matrimony

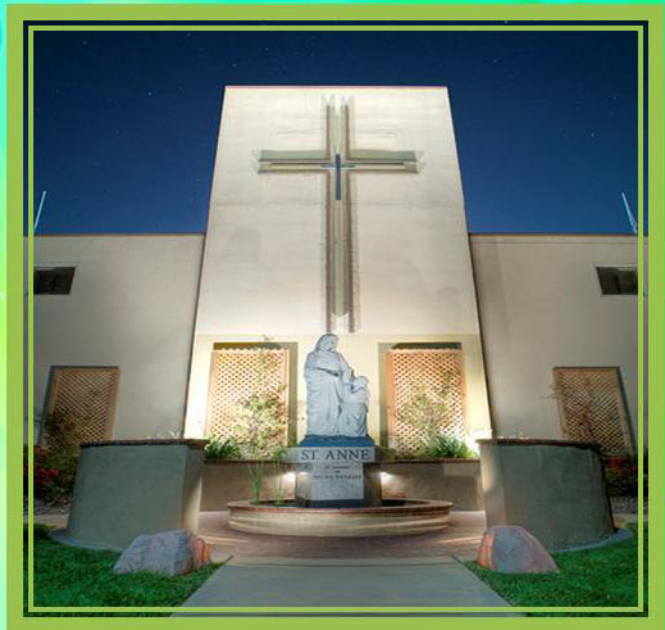
By appointment. Call Rectory at least 6 months ahead. Do not set any specific date without conferring with the Priest.

My dear friends in Christ,

“THROUGH THE YEARS! 40 YEARS of CELEBRATING OUR FAITH ANF GOD’S LOVE!”

This is an exciting time for us! As I said last weekend we are in this moment of grace. This year we are asked to reflect on our faith and our relationship with God and with one another! How do I live my faith? The gospel asks us to be the “salt of the earth and the light of the world!” This is our Christian mission and our identity!

I would like to reflect on this statement: We are Good Catholics but not Good Christians!

I was a good kid but not perfect. Growing up---- I had my moments in the sun. Even with my misgivings, my mother loves me unconditionally.

When I was six years old, I was helping my mother clean the house one Saturday morning. And something happened: *I broke a flower vase* that was not valuable but had quite sentimental value for my mother! It was a gift from my grandmother. *It happened because I wasn’t paying attention. I didn’t want to help her. I was not listening. I was talking. In fact I was complaining! As usual I was scolded and as usual I cried! Because I was GUILTY, right away I said to her, “Mom, I’m Sorry!” And she gave me a beautiful smile.*

Of course I did many more of these in my life. This is probably that has not changed in many of us. *We don’t listen! Do we do things from the heart?* Pope John Paul II said, *“External practice of the faith has no value if our heart is wicked!”*

Many of us try to be good Catholics but our experiences have not translated to being good Christians. We come to Mass every day or every Sunday, we do our novenas and rosaries. These are what make us GOOD CATHOLICS! But are we GOOD CHRISTIANS? DISCIPLES OF CHRIST? *When we are in the Church, we sing the praises of God’s word. But we forget the Gospel as soon as we leave the Church. In the gospel today from Luke, we are invited to live in forgiveness and mercy.*

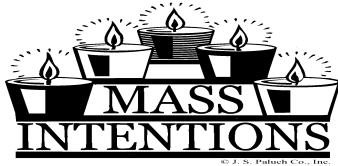
What does it mean to be a GOOD CHRISTIAN? A good Christian is someone who will always seek the highest good of his/her neighbor even that neighbor is his/her enemy. This is one of the reasons why Christianity spread like a wild fire in the early part of the first century. As one witness said, “Their love for each other was so evident.”

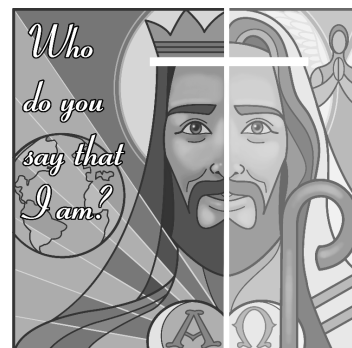
