*Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.*

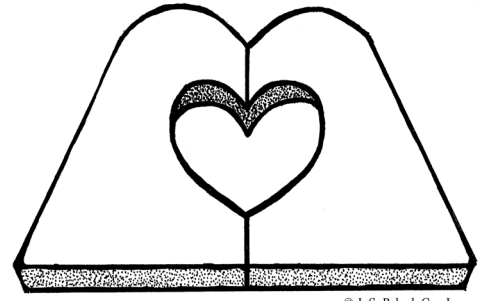

We gather as a community on that last Thursday of November at 10am to give thanks to our God for another beautiful year in our parish. Yes we have our own share of many challenges and headaches. 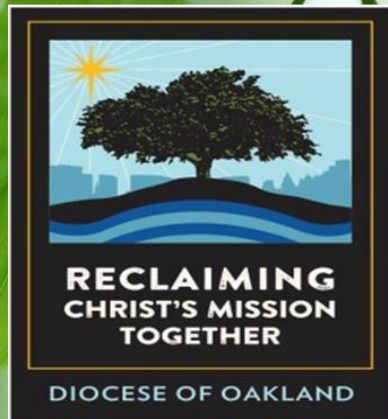

Our *Reclaiming Christ's Mission Together* Campaign Commitment Weekends take place this weekend until Nov. 8 here at St. Anne Catholic Church. Please consider your pledge to the campaign today. If you have not had an opportunity to make your pledge, please complete one of the pledge cards you received and place it in the Sunday Mass collection or drop it off at the St. Anne Church office.

#### Why is Pledging Vital?

A pledge allows you to make a continuous sacrifice that adds up to a significant contribution over a period of time.

A pledge makes payments less of a burden than a one-time gift.

A pledge gives the parish and Diocese an accurate estimate for future planning.

Your pledge is a statement of your intent to give to the best of your ability. Bishop Michael Barber and Fr. Geoffrey Baraan know that when you make your pledge, you will do your best to fulfill it. A 10% down payment is encouraged but not necessary.
