- by being the sign of unity and peace in the kingdom of God.

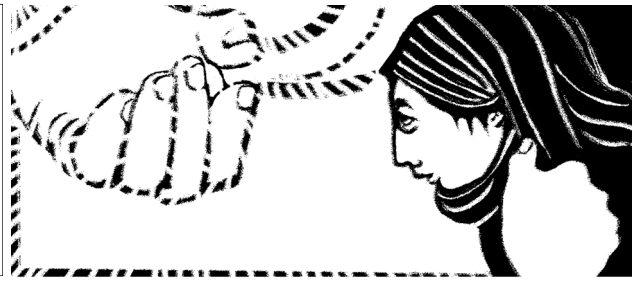
