What a better way to start the coming New Year than to possess a perfect determination to live for Christ in an ordinary day to day living.

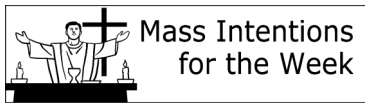
We will triumph because in joys and sorrows; in works and recreations; in prayers and in sacrifices, our Mother is leading us constantly to her Son.

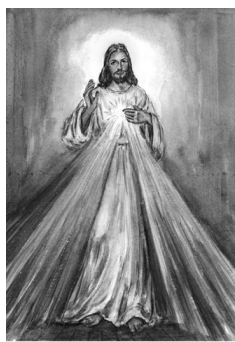
