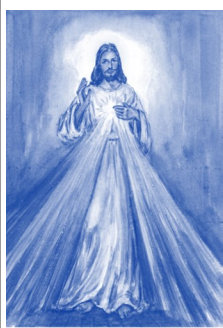
**ST. ANNE SCHOOL OF FAITH FORMATION

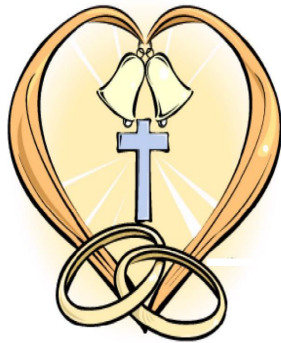
