Although this dispensation has been extended, all are encouraged to participate in prayer as Mass continues to be offered live stream. Those who are sick, not feeling well, and/or are at a higher risk of contracting the COVID-19 virus are encouraged to remain at home as an act of charity to all.

As we begin to resume public Mass, we ask for your continued prayers, understanding, patience, and cooperation as we celebrate the sacraments during this time of pandemic.
